The bottom number tells what kind of note gets the beat. In this example, 4/4 time, there are 4 beats per measure, and the quarter note (bottom 4) gets the beat. In 3/4 time, the quarter note would still get the beat, but there would only be 3 beats in a measure. In 6/8 time, the eighth note gets the beat, and there are 6 beats to a measure.

Basic Musical Notation - Method Behind the Music

The top number in the time signature will determine how many beats there are to be played per measure, while the bottom number represents each beat's note value. The example above, 4/4, is the most basic and widely-used time signature in popular music. In 4/4, there are four quarter notes assigned per
