In the New Testament, he is sometimes called the Spirit of Christ. The Holy Spirit first appears in the second verse of the Bible, in the account of creation :

To be a Christian is to have the Spirit of Christ. Romans 8:9: "You . . . are not in the flesh but in the Spirit, if in fact the Spirit of God dwells in you. Anyone who does not have the Spirit of Christ does not belong to him." So, no one is a Christian if he does not have the Holy Spirit.
